

## **The Schwenn Family Scholarship for PSU Transfer Students 2009-2010 (PCC Students admitted Fall 2008-Winter Term 2010)**

**The Schwenn Family Scholarship Fund for PSU Transfer Students** will support students transferring from Portland Community College's Rock Creek and/or Sylvania campuses who wish to complete their undergraduate degree at Portland State University. Newly admitted students to P.S.U from the designated PCC campuses for Fall Term 2009, as well as students who were new transfer admits during the most recent academic year (Fall Term 2008-Summer 2009) are eligible to apply. Students admitted for Winter Term 2010 also are eligible. At the time of admission to Portland State University, students must have earned **75 or more transferable college credits** and have earned a **cumulative college G.P.A. of 2.75**. Other eligibility criteria are **first-generation educational background** (i.e. parents or guardians did not earn bachelor's degrees) and **documented financial need**.

The number of Schwenn Family Scholarships for PSU Transfer Students will vary each year, with awards ranging from a total of \$1,000 to \$3,000 per student. Students will be notified before the start of Winter Term 2010, and disbursement of scholarship funds will be Winter Term 2010, Spring Term 2010, and Summer 2010, if the student is enrolled in summer classes. Awards are not automatically renewable; students must compete annually for the scholarship.

**Application Deadline: November 30, 2009.** Final selection of recipients will be made after grades are posted after the end of Fall Term. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

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### **Eligibility Criteria:**

An eligible student:

- Is a new, admitted transfer student from Rock Creek campus or Sylvania campus of Portland Community College Fall Term 2009 or Fall Term 2008 - Summer Term 2009, or is admitted for Winter Term 2010;
- Is enrolled at Portland State University for 8 or more credit hours during Fall Term 2009 (not applicable to new admits for Winter Term 2010);
- Has earned a minimum of 75 transferable college credits with a minimum college G.P.A. of 2.75;
- Has parents or guardians who have not earned Bachelor's degrees;
- Can document financial need;
- Presents evidence of a commitment to complete a first Bachelor's degree at Portland State.

### **Application Checklist:**

- Complete application form ( "scholarship button" on <http://www.eeps.pdx>);
- Include copies (unofficial) of all college transcripts;
- Include copy of Fall Term 2009 course schedule;
- Write a personal statement describing your educational goals at Portland State and your future career goals;
- Provide an academic plan for Winter Term 2010, Spring Term 2010, and Summer Term 2010 (if you plan to attend Summer Term) that outlines the classes you plan to take;
- Provide a copy of your 2009-2010 financial aid award, or if you do not have financial aid, a detailed explanation of your financial need and any documents that support your financial situation;
- Provide a budget of your income and expenses;
- One letter of recommendation from a Portland State University or Portland Community College instructor regarding your academic abilities and potential for degree completion.

15. Request a letter of recommendation from a P.S.U. or P.C.C. instructor or professor who knows your academic abilities and potential to complete a Bachelor's degree. Ask the instructor to give the letter to you in a sealed, signed envelope and submit it with your other application documents.
